## Fall Theme - God's Promise, Our Promises

We are excited this fall to explore some of the most beloved stories of our faith — stories of the Old Testament that tell us about God's Promises to God's people, and the peoples' responses to those promises. They are stories that tell us about God's Love for us; and that help us ask important questions about how we are meant to respond to and share that inclusive, boundary-breaking Love in our own lives and communities.
