What a wonderful all-church retreat!

On Saturday and Sunday, November 8th and 9th, sixty three UCWers enjoyed time with each other at Rolling Ridge Retreat Center in North Andover. Drawing from the writing of the Apostle Paul in 1 Cor 12: 12-27, the theme for the weekend was "Body Building." We explored and experienced together "What is it to be the body of Christ and individual members of it." Through song, drama, reflection, play, worship, arts and crafts, and games we uncovered and celebrated the gifts that each of us have and how they can be of service in the building up of our church community and how our church community can be of service in building up the world.

The retreat began with Jandi leading us in singing followed by a rousing bingo game where we had to match clues with the people gathered. Our guest Melody Ward danced as Bart read our scripture from 1 Cor 12. Brita then led us in a playful and provocative exercise of identifying what member of the body we are and what gifts we bring to the wider UCW body.



After lunch adults had the choice of four different break out groups one of which a conversation about mission that Kent Wittler facilitated. Notes from that break out session are included here. During this time, the children were engaged in their own learning and play exploring the theme of church as the body of Christ.

Saturday evening after dinner and more time for conversation, we enjoyed the "Marshmallow Challenge," a bonfire, singing, and some rousing board games in the library.

New Bible Study Group Forming!




