Jesus undersigned members of the Union Church in Waban, affirming the inclusive love of Jesus, are moved to bear witness to the tragic school shootings in Nashville, to the state house demonstrations and protests by the people of Tennessee, and to the senseless retaliation by the majority of the Tennessee House of Representatives voting to silence the people by expelling Rep Justin Pearson and Rep. Justin Jones and punishing you for standing with them. Instead of addressing measures to prevent more gun violence, the rulers of the House chose to defend their decorum, thereby trivializing the loss of life and ignoring the grief and the outcries of communities traumatized by endless gun violence. They chose love for guns over love for children.

We fully support your vigorous, inspiring protest and steadfast refusal to allow the voices for justice in the House chamber to be silenced. We are heartened by the quick action of the constituents of Reps Jones and Pearson that will enable the Tennessee Three to continue to be even stronger now to give voice to the countless victims of gun violence in this country. Most importantly, your presence on the front line with Reps. Pearson and Jones in direct action and agitation for racial justice fortify our understanding that the incidents of gun violence that move us to pray and protest are but one of many inhumane manifestations of racial injustice that we can no longer tolerate in any part of this country.
